



A Walk in the Woods



The main curriculum focus of this term's topic is science. We will be exploring seasonal change, classifying a range of common trees and animals, planting spring bulbs and looking at the structure of trees and plants. In geography 'Leafman' will help us to use the simple points on a compass out in the school grounds.

English

The character of Tattybogle will be the inspiration for much of our writing. We will continue to develop our use of 'sentence ingredients', including question and exclamation marks. During guided reading sessions we will be exploring the suffixes ed, ing, s and es, using information texts.

Computing

We will be using iPads to; record sounds, insert text and photographs as well as to promote e-safety whilst using the internet to research woodland animals.

P.S.H.E.E.

Our PSHEE focus this term is on personal safety and will include firework safety, anti-bullying and road safety.
