Internet Safety Week

This week it has been internet safety week. The digital leaders led the school in Collective Worship highlighting some tips on how to be safe online. School is also going to be working on an Online safety project with the local authority and St Laurence which will support the school in updating our Online Safety Policy, provide training for Staff as well as a parent workshop.

With Online safety in mind, we've received a few reports of some apps being promoted to children that are potentially unsafe. 'Blaze and The Monster Machines' and 'Five Nights at Freddys' have both caused concerns regarding offensive language and violent content. We strongly advise parents to check children's devices for content; especially as some of these apps can initially appear very innocent with childlike animation and illustrations.

Lots of children are also using the app $\underline{\text{musical.ly}}$. Can I remind parents that this is app is aimed at over 13's and not appropriate for Primary age children. If you would like some guidance on privacy settings for this app, there is a leaflet on the school website.
