"Thank you all for your support during this academic year. Our fundraising total at the moment stands at £21155, which is absolutely amazing! This money makes such a difference to the school. Over the past year we have, amongst other things, purchased £250 of books for every year group, bought KS1 a new reading scheme, provided money for materials for Arts Week, paid for lunchtime sports clubs, bought two replacement microphones for the hall, paid for World Book Day author visits, supported the KS1 Nativity and Year 6 production and provided money for Emotional Literacy Resources. We have also raised £10000 to allow the school to purchase a Radio Station. Next year we turn our attention to the school grounds, look out for more information on this at the start of next term!
