TERMS AND CONDITIONS

A place will not be reserved for your child unless we receive a completed registration form, medical form and cheque or cash in advance.

If pupils are attending more than one of the clubs detailed, then you only need to complete one form.

NB: Please list all the clubs that they are attending.

Please could you ensure that all the necessary forms are completed and returned to the school office by the morning of **Tuesday 27/03/2018** in order for us to be able to process them and produce registers in time for **Thursday 29/03/2018**. It is imperative that we have all the necessary information and medical details prior to the clubs starting so your immediate attention is required. In some cases the number of spaces is limited and in the event that we are oversubscribed we will draw names from a hat.

NB: If your child is in receipt of free school meals (KS2) we can offer a discount on the cost of clubs. Pupils can register at any time for most of the clubs. Please check at school office.

CONFIRMATION OF BOOKINGS

Lists will be put up on the After School Clubs notice board situated at the top of the stairs in Berryfield hall on the right hand side before you go down the steps to the Foundation Classrooms.

Lists will go up during the day on Thursday 29/03/2018.

CANCELLATIONS

We will phone you if a club has been cancelled, and if a club is oversubscribed. Clubs will go ahead unless weather conditions are very poor. We will cancel a club if we do not have enough pupils to be able to run it. The charges made for the clubs do not cover administrative costs to organise and run them. Therefore, if a club is cancelled we will not be able to issue refunds.

We will give pupils' contact and medical details to Mrs Bethan Sheff (Pottery teacher), Mrs Claire Yeoman (Art teacher), Mrs Suzanne Briggs (Art teacher), if they need to contact you for a cancellation or an emergency.

FOOTBALL - Year 1 to 4

This club provides children with the opportunity to develop their Football skills through warm up games, drills and training matches. Pupils must wear astroturf trainers or football boots and shin pads and warmer clothes when the weather is colder. Pupils will not be allowed to play with trainers. Pupils will play in Christ Church hall when weather conditions are poor.**

Mr Jonathon Douglass will be running this club. He will meet pupils in his classroom (6JD). Pupils will play in Christ Church hall when weather conditions are poor. There will be a maximum of 18 pupils.

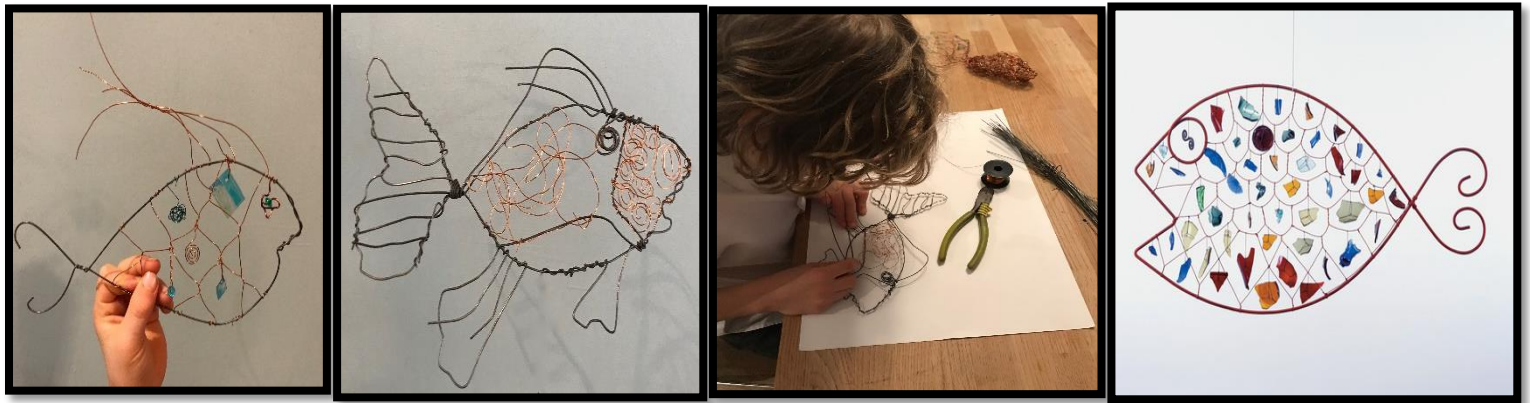


ART and SCULPTURE KS2 (Wednesday)
