Welcome back to our final term together! We are going to be travelling around the UK with Paddington Bear. Finding out about the different countries, their capital cities, customs and geographical features. Towards the end of term the children will learn about 'Darkest Peru', looking for similarities and differences with the UK.

#### **Geography and Science**
