Online Learning Journals

Thank you for your contributions to the on-line learning journals. It has been lovely to see what your children enjoy doing. This term could you send us observations on the theme of 'Technology'. Our Early Learning Goal is: that children recognise that a <u>range of technology</u> is used in places such as homes and schools and that <u>they select and use technology for particular</u> <u>purposes</u>. We get to see the children use ipads and computers in school so it would be great to see them using and discussing technology at home. Ideas include: using toys, smart TVs, Alexa/Siri, scanners (e.g in the library or a supermarket), helping to buy shopping on-line or anything you use technology for at home.

Phonics and Reading We are so proud of the progress the children are making in reading. Thank you for your support, <u>daily reading</u> <u>makes a huge difference</u>. We have noticed the children find recognising digraphs (2 letters that make one sound such as ch, ai, ee) and trigraphs (3 letters that make one sound such as igh, air) more challenging. Please keep practising these with your posters. We are consolidating Phase 3 Phonics over the next few weeks so additional practise will make a big difference.







Spring & Easter

We will be looking for signs of Spring and talking about the changes we have noticed over time. We will also be learning about Easter and talking about how we celebrate this with our families.
