Welcome back to Term 4.

History will be one of our main areas of learning this term. After travelling back in time, we will be finding out about the lives and achievements of the Ancient Greeks and what legacy they left behind.

Another of our main themes will be 'electricity' where we will explore how to make circuits work. We will be combining these skills with our D&T unit which will be to make a board game with electrical components. Board games need lots of people to play them so please come along on **Friday 5<sup>th</sup> April at 3:00** to join the children playing their games.

PSHEE this term, will focus on 'healthy minds and healthy bodies'. We will be exploring how we can express our feelings and also thinking about how to respond and react to peer pressure.

We will be thinking about what forgiveness is and how Jesus forgave those who persecuted him. Hopefully, we will have the opportunity to pose some questions to one of our Christian visitors about what forgiveness means to them.

This term's PE sessions will be gymnastics and tennis and will continue to be on the same days (Wednesday afternoon and Thursday morning). We are very fortunate that both sessions will be taught by Mr Kiely.
