

Curriculum Overview for Early Years Foundation Stage Hedgehogs and Otters Term 6

Personal, Social & Emotional Development

- Ensuring that children know how to find support when they need help or information.
- Talk about the changes from Foundation to Year 1.
- Talk about others having different points of view during circle time.
- Discuss how to resolve minor conflicts by listening to each other and coming up with a fair solution

Communication & Language

- Talk about things that they have enjoyed in Foundation.
- Follow instructions involving several ideas and in response to stories or events.
- Listen to stories without pictures or props.
- Use a range of vocabulary in imaginative ways.

Physical Development

- Hop and skip in time to music.
- Write on the line and begin to control the letter size.
- Move confidently in a range of ways.
- Practise skills and using equipment for sports day.

Literacy

- Use phonic knowledge to decode words and read them aloud.
- Read words and simple sentences.
- Read phonically regular words of more than one syllable.
- Read and spell some tricky words independently.
- Begin to use key features of narrative in their writing.

Mathematics

- Estimate quantities and check by careful counting.
- Solve practical problems such as sharing quantities into equal groups.
- Solve mathematical problems including doubling, halving, adding and subtracting.
- Talk about properties of 2D and 3D shapes.

Understanding of the World

- Discuss similarities and differences in relation to places, communities and traditions
- Talk about the features of their own environment and how environments might vary from one another

Expressive Arts & Design

- Develop ideas through selecting and using materials and working on processes that interest them.
- Use a variety of materials, tools and techniques, experimenting with colour, design, texture, form and function.
- Talk about ideas and processes which have led them to make music, designs, images
