

Foundation Stage

Welcome back, we hope you had a nice break. Thank you for completing the 'Proud Cloud' to support us with our Technology evidence. We would also like to thank you for your support with our Jack and the Beanstalk performance. It was great to see the children performing with such confidence. Our farm trip was really successful, the children had a great day. We cannot believe we have come to our final term. We are so proud of the progress the children have made over the year and we have thoroughly enjoyed teaching them.

As we have a long term ahead, we will be finishing our topic on Jack and the Beanstalk for the first week back. We will then begin our new topic which will involve finding out about life in another country. We will reveal our new topic to the children over several days by sharing clues with them.

Sports Day

The children will take part in their first Sports Day at Christ Church school. Please ensure that they have a full water bottle, sun cream has been applied and that they have their PE kit in school. The children stay with their house teams and take part in a carousel of activities. They come back to the classroom at the end of the day and will be dismissed as usual.

Reading and Phonics

Please continue to read daily with your child and practise tricky words. We will be practising spelling tricky words: he, she, we, me, be, was, you, they, all are, my and her. Some children have now progressed on to our spelling scheme, please take time over each booklet as the children need to be able to apply these spellings to their writing independently.

Transition to Year One

During this term we will be doing lots of transition activities such as visiting the class rooms and finding out about Year One. The children will also have the opportunity to spend the day in their new class room on July 4th. This is an exciting time for most children however please talk to us if your child is feeling particularly worried.

Show and Tell

Many children enjoy bringing in items to share with their peers. If your child brings anything to school please make sure it is linked to our learning or is a celebration of an achievement (e.g swimming certificates) and that it is named. We may not do show and tell on the day they bring the item into school. Your child needs to be able to talk about what they have brought in and answer questions about the item.

Please ensure your child has a sunhat for warmer weather and that it is clearly labelled with their name.
