# Homework

- ▶ 45 mins per subject.
- ▶ High expectations- **should** match standard of classroom work
- ▶ Immediate consequence of detention when not in.
- ▶ If, for good reason, homework has not been completed, we would need a note from parents explaining why, so we can act appropriately.
- ▶ Spellings and TT Rockstars are an expected part of home learning.

# Spellings:

- ▶ Spellings will be taught within class as part of our SPaG curriculum.
- ▶ 'Country' spellings are alongside this and should be practised regularly at home.
- ▶ There will be a weekly session for spelling testing, for those children that are ready.
- ▶ If children aren't forthcoming with asking to be tested, we will test them as required to ensure progress is happening.

# Reading & times tables

- ▶ Frequent times table testing- absolutely crucial skills for this year.
- ▶ TT Rock Stars will be continuing, including weekly inter class battles
- ▶ Comprehension book marks available; it is very important to discuss books at home to further understanding.
- ▶ Try to avoid fleeting between different books to build up endurance and understanding of characters and story.

# Pencil cases

- ▶ Each child expected to have a pencil case
- ▶ We will equip them as needed but it is their responsibility to organise themselves.
- ▶ If children wish to, they are welcome – but not required- to bring in a notebook for jotting down of ideas during lessons. This does not need to be a fancy one!

# Interventions

- ▶ Maths morning group
- ▶ Interventions can be for everyone (to master subject for example)
- ▶ Interventions could only be for one week or maybe longer.

# PE Kit and Uniform

- ▶ This year, on a Tuesday (PPA) children are expected to come into school in their PE kit.
- ▶ On other PE days (Monday), children should come to school in their school uniform and have their kit ready to change into later in the day.
- ▶ In preparation for secondary school, uniform expectations are very high. Children should come to school in correct uniform including black school shoes.
- ▶ If there is an issue with uniform, children should bring in a note explaining so that we can act appropriately.

# Healthy snacks:

- ▶ We are a Healthy Eating school and therefore snacks for play time should be either fruit or vegetables.


