Foundation Stage Term 1 September 2019 All About Me

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This term we are focussing on settling into school life and learning the many routines. We are learning all about each other, talking about ourselves and our interests and making new friends.

In Foundation Stage we use the children's interests to plan our topics and the children are closely involved with this process. We talk about being 'Learning Explorers' and call our self-directed learning time 'Explore Time'. During this time the children will access play based activities designed to support them develop their skills in areas of the Early Years curriculum. As our learning progresses we discuss ideas and record them in a class planning book. Do visit our learning displays outside Hedgehogs classroom from time to time as we add pictures throughout the year. All the children freely explore our many inside and outside learning activities and are encouraged to try new things. The children are also taught in focussed whole class sessions, small groups and in one-to-one sessions throughout the school day.
