We will therefore send children home in their PE kits on a Tuesday and ask that they come back to school dressed in their PE kit every Wednesday. Kits must be returned to school the following week ready for their Tuesday PE session.

The Community Garden

A huge thank you to Lizzie Munday (Christopher's mum) and any other Year 2 parents who helped with the garden. It looks absolutely brilliant and we already have lots of exciting ideas as to how we are going to use it and incorporate it into our curriculum!

Our topic this term focuses on habitats around the world and the flora and fauna that live in them. We will base our topic on the book 'Meerkat Mail'. Science, Geography and English will be the main topic drivers as we will learn about the diet, habitats and life cycles of a variety of different species. We will also involve Dance and Music ('The Carnival of the Animals' by Saint Saens).

In English we will be writing non fiction texts about animals and habitats and writing some of our own poems. In maths we will looking at place value, addition and subtraction, fractions and time.
