

Year 6 Term 2:

What's through the window?

Welcome back to another fun-filled term, Year 6!

This term we have been issued a special commission by Mr. Baker: he would like us to write and publish a history of Christ Church Primary School. We will take on the role of archivists and historians to build up a detailed picture of how our school has changed throughout its history, finishing with an 'open museum' at the end of term where we will exhibit some of the records we have looked at and share our findings.

In **English**, we will be writing letters from a range of historical perspectives and exploring how poets and authors have used the imagery of windows to tell stories. Our **artwork** will also focus on our local area, using observational drawing to develop unique pieces about what we see around us, whilst in **Computing** we will create video reports about our school. Our work in **Maths** will cover division, fractions and statistics.

As Christmas approaches, our **RE** work will lead us to discuss who Jesus was and what Christians can learn from his example. This will be supported by a visit to our church for an experience linking to RE week towards the end of term. In **PSHEE** we will explore ways to cope with disagreements and arguments.
