<u>Reading and Tricky Words</u>

- Please can you ensure that your child's reading book is in school <u>every day</u> with their reading log and tricky word cards. Please aim to read daily with your child at home and record in their reading log, a quick comment or an initial will do.
- Please use your phonics folder to keep practicing quick recognition and word building. Phase 3 (purple sound mat) sounds take longer for the children to become confident therefore daily practicing at home little and often makes a huge difference.
- All children should now have these tricky word cards and be practicing sight reading them: I, to, the, no, go, into, he, she, we, me, be.
- Please remember to hand in a slip when your child can confidently sight read these. (More slips are available on the noticeboard outside Hedgehog Classroom)
