

English

In English, the children will be writing a newsletter to tell you about Mr Baker's stolen bacon sandwich! They will also be writing character descriptions of the wolf and writing instructions to show him how to make a vegetarian sandwich! By the end of the term we will have also written our very own twisted tales.

Throughout this writing we will be focusing on the four sentence types; exclamation, command, statement and question. We will consolidate suffixes, apostrophes for possession and contractions as well as learning about homophones and new word endings such as -tion, -le, -il, -al. In order to ensure that our writing is brilliant, we will be learning how to edit our work using our 'editing friends'.

In our guided reading sessions, we will be reading a variety of traditional and twisted tales and retelling them through drama. Whilst reading these books, we will be continuing to develop our inference, sequencing and comparison skills

Creative Curriculum

This topic builds upon the knowledge of traditional tales in Year 1. However, these tales have a slight twist to them!

We will launch our topic with Mr Baker having his bacon sandwich stolen! But who did it?! Was it Goldilocks? Little Red Riding Hood? Or the Big, Bad Wolf? Let's hope we find out!

We will land our topic by reading our own tales to the children in Foundation.

Maths

In Maths, we will be focusing on 2D and 3D shape, using vocabulary such as vertices, edges, symmetry and right angles. We will also be looking at direction and position, length, height and temperature. Throughout the term we will continue to develop our ability to recall multiplication and division facts for the 2x, 5x and 10x tables.
