Dear Parents.

I wanted to write to you following the national update of COVID-19 regarding school closures and how we at Christ Church are responding to this.

Before I go any further, I would like to take the opportunity to thank you all for your support and patience over this critical time. Your understanding of us having to respond to the changing landscape is much appreciated.

The government has asked that children are kept at home wherever possible and asked that we remain open for those children who absolutely need to attend. We will remain open for those children who are classified as vulnerable and where the child's parents have been identified as a key worker This type of provision is different to the typical school day as it is about care – keeping children safe and allowing workers to go to work and care for the sick or keep the critical infrastructure in place.

A couple of housekeeping/admin issues:

If your child has milk through Cool Milk please ensure you cancel the direct debit.

From Monday the Sladesbrook entrance and side gate will be closed. All entry or exit from the school will be through the main entrance on Berryfield Road.

The office will remain open between 8.00am and 12.00 noon. Please use admin@christchurch.wilts.sch.uk to make contact with the school. If you have an emergency or safeguarding concern each Designated Safeguarding Lead (DSL) or Deputy DSL will have a temporary mobile number.
