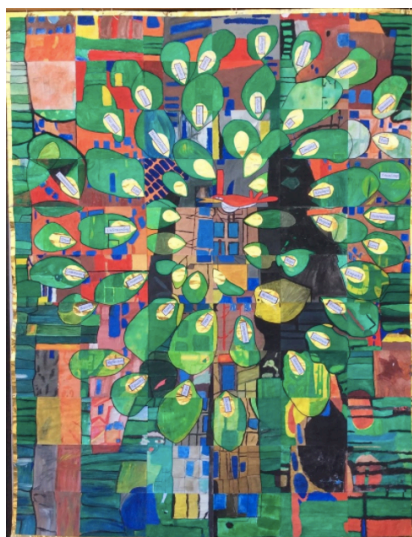


We hope this finds you and all of your friends and family well. This has probably been the strangest academic year any of us have experienced.
