Weekly Routines

Reading Books

We will ask the children to bring their phonetic reading book and their Reading Record into school every day. Their reading books will be changed every **Tuesday**.

Spellings

Children will be given spellings linked to their learning in school. Spelling tests will take place on **Tuesday** followed by new spellings being handed out.

Snack

As in Year 2, we will be providing a piece of fruit or vegetable each morning for snack.

After such a topsy-turvy end to the year, we are all super excited to be back at school and starting this year 2 adventure together.

Our first topic focuses on endangered animals and their habitats around the world. Science, Geography and English will be the main topic drivers. In Science, will learn about food chains, diet, habitats and microhabitats of several endangered species. In Geography, we will look at where the endangered animals live and we will be locating the world's seven continents and five oceans. In English, we will be consolidating sentence structure and writing non-fiction texts, instructions and our own poems about a very special endangered animal. In maths we will focus on place value and addition and subtraction.
