

## Phonics Websites and Apps

In a normal year your child would have taken a phonics screening check at the end of Year 1. However, due to lock down, this was not possible. As a result, all Year 2s nationally will be taking the check towards the end of next term. The check involves children sitting 1:1 with Mrs Farrell and reading 40 real and nonsense words. This is to assess whether they are able to apply the graphemes taught in Year 1. In order to pass the check the children need to get about 32 out of 40 correct. However, the pass mark can change and we will not know this until all national data is collected. The children normally love having some 1:1 time and reading the words. The special sticker awarded at the end is also an added bonus! If you would like to practise phonics with your child then we have given you some links below that revise the phonics taught in Year 1.

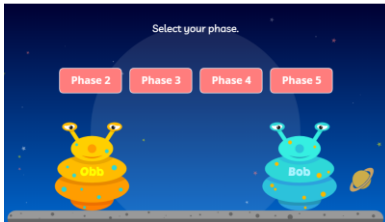
