Dear Parents and Carers,

I am sending this brief message following the announcement given by the Prime Minister this evening. It was made clear that schools will now close to all pupils except those whose parents are key workers or who have been classified as vulnerable.

Therefore I ask that only those children of parents who have already registered as key workers attend school tomorrow (Tuesday 5th January). Parents of children who are classified as vulnerable will be contacted tomorrow to discuss their child's return to school. FUNdays Early Morning Club will only be open for key workers' children tomorrow. FUNdays will assess the situation and issue a further statement tomorrow. Following my letter of earlier today, we have had further requests to register key worker status. Once these applications have been confirmed by employers, the child will be able to return to school.

For those whose children are not in school tomorrow, contact will be made after 10 am, and information shared about registration onto Google Classrooms for online learning. If your child is not in school and in receipt of free school meals, you will be contacted to outline the process for claiming your entitlement.

If your child is eligible to attend school tomorrow, the timings for the start and end of the day will be as they were before Christmas. It is expected that children in school will be attending full-time.

We will issue further correspondence as necessary. We are really sorry that we will not be welcoming all the children back to school as we were expecting.
