Literacu

In Phonics we will be beginning the next Phase of Letters and Sounds. This is phase 4 which focuses on adjacent consonants at the beginning and end of words e.g <u>frog</u> and mi<u>lk</u>. We will be introducing the phase 4 High Frequency Words including some 'tricky' words.

Please continue with <u>daily reading-this makes a</u> <u>huge difference</u>. Reading continues to be an important focus for us. You can also use the Big Cat reading books on line using your log in.

In guided writing we will be writing sentences which can be read by the children and others using and applying our phonics knowledge. To do this effectively we must apply our handwriting knowledge and the correct letter formation.

High Frequency Words

Please continue to practice reading these at home, we will be working on both reading and spelling these to improve our fluency in both reading and writing.

Understanding the World

We will be looking at life cycles of butterflies, plants and frogs. We will be planting sunflower seeds and we hope to have some visitors in our classrooms to look after and observe.

Physical Development

Handwriting will be a focus this term. The children are now familiar with all of the letters and numbers and we will work on the correct formation for each letter family. More information to follow.

We will be sending home some parent share observations this term. You have already accepted the invitations which we sent out pre-lockdown!
