Our topic this term is Light and Shadow.

In **maths**, we will be revisiting column subtraction. We will then move on to more work on fractions and finally we will be tackling TIME!

Please can we ask that you make a point of talking about time with your children often as this really helps to embed their understanding.

In **English**, our focus is poetry. We will be looking at many different forms of poetry throughout the term with the aim of writing and performing our own rap poems.

In **science**, we are exploring light and shadow. We will be discussing night and day and creating shadow puppets. This will be linked with **DT** where we are investigating how pulleys, levers and cogs work with the aim of designing our own model of the earth's movement around the sun.

In Art, we are looking at how to represent 3D objects using shading. We will also be exploring colour through making our own paper for collage.

Computing will centre around the creation of Branching Tree data bases.

In **RE**, we are looking at miracles old and new and discussing them.

The children will be doing athletics and tennis this term in PE.
