In **Science** and **Computing** we will be exploring two major technologies that impact on our everyday lives: electricity and the internet. In **RE** we will explore the question 'How can following God bring freedom and justice?'. Within this unit we will be exploring the life of Moses and how his passing on of the Ten Commandments affects Christians today.
