Welcome back to Term five and what a busy term we have in store!

After a fascinating time exploring the times and lives of the Greeks, we now turn our attention to the Anglo-Saxons, and their rivals: the Vikings. To kick off, we will find out where the Vikings and Anglo Saxons came from, why they came to Britain and where they settled, with our overarching enquiry being to look at the reasoning behind their coming to Britain.

In English we will be exploring the text of Beowulf and using it to create our own narrative based on the story as well as brushing up on our year 4 punctuation and grammar skills.

In geography we will be taking a look at the continent of Europe in relation to our topic to further understand where the Anglo Saxons and Vikings came from.

In maths we will be taking an in-depth look at division before moving on to learning about shape and symmetry.

In art, we will be looking at the Lewis chessman pieces and creating our own versions using clay.

In computing we will initially be finishing our look at animation before extending our knowledge of E-safety.
