Once again this year, our benefice will be joining the global ecumenical prayer movement known as Thy Kingdom Come, where Christians are encouraged to pray for five people to come to know Jesus. This is the 10th year of this worldwide initiative where every

person, household and church are invited to pray. Although there are no beginnings or endings for prayer, Thy Kingdom Come starts on Ascension Day (Thursday 29th May) and ends on the day of Pentecost (8th June).

So over the coming days I would like to invite you to prayerfully consider who your five might be; THY KINGDOM COM perhaps family, friends or those we are connected with through all that we do in our communities. And as we commit them to prayer for the 10 days of Thy Kingdom Come, we could also reach out to them through a phone call, or a get together. After all, God has placed them on our hearts for a reason.



We have the privilege of being God's co-workers in Christ (1 Corinthians 3:9) but it is He who builds his church. This time of prayer can be an opportunity for us to ask God to do iust that.



To help us on this 10 day journey, we could take the time to pray in one of our four churches. Our churches all have specific prayer corners within them, and my thanks go to those who care for these. There is something special about praying in a church building. I often think that the walls and the spaces within must be saturated with the prayers of the faithful over the years. What a privilege it is to join those who have gone before us in this way, by adding our prayers to theirs.

So as we approach the 29th May, please think about who your five might be as I hope we will join with our fellow Christians around the world (so far this movement spans 90% of the countries in the world across 85 denominations).
