

Dear Friends

Taking time to pause to remember is important, it matters more than perhaps we might realise. This is often best seen in the impact that a telephone call from an old friend or an unexpected birthday card through the post has on our emotions. That moment of joy when we hear the voice at the end of the phone or the smile that comes to our face as we realise that someone has thought of us.

Last week we had our annual service for the loss of a loved one, which provided a precious space to pause, reflect, and give thanks for those who have meant so much to us. The memories that were shared in conversation afterwards over tea and cake reminded me of how shared stories and shared experiences, help to shape our identity and the way that we live.

In many ways remembering helps to connect the past, the present and the future. Which is why up and down the country this Sunday, we will be taking time out of the normal rhythm of life to pause to remember those who have given their lives to defend the freedom of both us and others. And as we pause at 11 o'clock, in recognition that it was at this hour on the 11th November 1918 that the guns fell silent, we are also reminded that right now, all over the world, the sounds, sights and smells of war are a lived reality.



As we remember the past and honour the names of those who gave their lives, we do so rooted in the present and as such we need to pledge ourselves once again to strive for all that makes for peace, to seek to heal the wounds of war, and to work for a just future for all humanity. Freedom can never be taken for granted but requires us to give of ourselves; living lives where we seek to follow the greatest commandment of loving our neighbour as ourselves. Whilst we remember the great sacrifice of others, we also need to offer our own small daily sacrifice: seeking to place others first, striving to be peace-makers and living lives overflowing with love. This is the path that Jesus has asked us to follow, the path that led him to the cross. Freedom comes at a cost, are we prepared to roll up our sleeves and follow?

Go forth into the world in peace; be of good courage; hold fast that which is good; render no one evil for evil; strengthen the faint-hearted; support the weak; help the afflicted; honour everyone; love and serve the Lord, rejoicing in the power of the Holy Spirit.




