

# SPRINGTIME ON THE FARM

Vocabulary	Definition
<b>Spring</b>	Spring is also the season when trees, plants, and flowers start to bud, grow and bloom. Plants need water, light, warmth, and soil or compost to grow. Young animals are born such as chicks and lambs
<b>Farm</b>	A farm is a piece of land used to grow crops and/or raise animals for produce. People who grow this produce are called "farmers", and their work is called "farming".
<b>Life cycle</b>	A life cycle is a series of stages a living thing goes through during its life. All plants and animals go through life cycles
<b>Roots</b>	is a part of a plant that is usually hidden underground. Roots have several purposes. They hold the plant in the ground and keep it upright. They take water and food from the soil
<b>Stem</b>	It grows above ground and helps support the plant
<b>Leaves</b>	A leaf is <b>part of a plant that's usually green and attached to it by a stem or stalk.</b> Leaves help produce the food
<b>Flower</b>	It is part of the plant that blossoms and helps produce seeds
<b>Fair trade</b>	Farmers in developing countries get a fair price for their produce such as bananas, coffee and chocolate
<b>Seed</b>	Seeds are the small parts produced by plants from which new plants grow
